ISPS HANDA Scandinavian Blind Golf Open 2023

SBGA will be hosting the **Scandinavian Blind Golf Open** from 14 – 16 August 2023. This 36 hole event will take place at Sollentuna Golf Club, Stockholm Sweden.

We would like to invite international and local players to apply for entry to this event. At this first-time occasion, the entry fee (150€) will be covered by the local organization.

Schedule of the week

Sunday 13 th August	Arrive at Arlanda International Airport
Monday 14 th August	Practice round
Tuesday 15 th August	1 st Round of Championship
Wednesday 16 th August	2 nd Round of Championship Gala Dinner & Prize-giving
Thursday 17 th	Departure

Play will be in pairs. The Rules of Golf and Modifications for Blind Golfers will apply. A Referee will be available, and their decision will be final. There will also be a club member in each pair to provide guidance and support during every round.

Transport & Accommodation

Players should fly into Arlanda Airport
There is a taxi rank immediately outside arrivals at a cost of around 35€ to the hotel

Accommodation will be for free, and will be at the Scandic Star Hotel, Sollentuna. A suburban station is just outside of the hotel. Transport to and from the hotel to the golf course will be provided by the transport company Samtrans. All travels to and from the golf course will be provided free of charge.

For people who want to stay addition nights to explore Stockholm, a special hotel deal has been agreed with the hotel.

Meals

Meals provided:

- Breakfasts: 14th -17th (at hotel)
- Lunches: lunches at Sollentuna Golf Club 14th – 16th of August
- Closing Dinner: Evening of August 16th

The Course

The course's location and good quality make it one of Stockholm's most popular and well-visited courses. SoGK is in Rotebro, 20 km north of Stockholm City and is a moderately difficult park course in a scenic setting.

The course dates from 1967, designed by course architect Nils Sköld, and the club was elected to the Swedish Golf Association in 1969 as golf club no. 112.

Your Playing Handicap will be based on the WHS Handicap Index or if you do not have a WHS Handicap Index you will use your IBGA Index.

You should let us know your WHS ID. The Course is a Par 72. The competition will be played from tee 54 (5284 meters) for men and tee 49 (4939 meters) for ladies.

The practice area will be free of charge for players.

At this moment, we can only confirm a limited numbers of Golf buggies will be available free of charge (normally 30€/round), for reservation, please see entry form.

Tournament

We plan to offer the following prizes:

- Best Gross: B1, B2 & B3
- Best Net B1, B2 & B3
- Overall Net (all players combined): 1st, 2nd and 3rd
- Women's Gross & Net: Winner (only if there are 2 or more entrants)
- Stableford Division: Winner

Should two or more players tie for a particular prize the countback to determine the winner will be based on the approved IBGA countback procedure.

Additional prizes for spectacular achievements during the competition will also be presented.
